

BAR MADE FROM OLD TABLE TOP AND PALLETS

I found some salvaged flooring from a mill in Marshall, NC. The flooring is 2 ½" thick tongue and groove pine, very old and heavy. It's ideal for making beefy wooden legs for bars and tables. Here I used half of an old table top I salvaged from a homeowner in Asheville, and added pallet wood pieces for the front and shelf in back. I splayed out the legs a bit for that artsy style. Makes a statement piece for any home or patio.





Roughly 60" long, 18" deep, 42" high. Top is roughly 1-1/2" thick.
