

BUTCHER BLOCK TABLE WITH DESK LEGS

I found a butcher block work table that had seen better days. It came from a metal worker's shop in the River Arts District of Asheville. After I did a lot of cleaning and sanding, I exposed the raw maple wood underneath. I added a pair of cast iron legs from a turn-of-the-century student desk, the result is a unique dining table, craft table, or desk.





Table is 71" long, 31" wide, and 30" high. Top is about 1.5" thick.
