



We bring new life to vintage finds. In Asheville we found an old student cast iron folding desk, the kind used in the early 1900's. We pulled it apart and salvaged the beautiful cast iron legs. Then added a top made from pine paneling pulled out of a local home. The paneling was stained a light gray, which didn't contrast enough with the black cast iron, so we sanded most of it off, leaving a little bit for character.

We built the undercarriage out of repurposed lumber and left it bare to show off the cast iron. Then we added some feet and two basket pull out drawers.



This would make a great craft table, artist table, or inclined desk. Certainly a statement piece for any workplace or home office! This is a one-of-kind piece.
