



I found an old metal desk set in Arden, it was loosely assembled and had a glass top that was badly scratched. I removed the glass, tightened up all the screws, spray painted it a glossy black, and made a new top out of some pallet wood. The pallets were various colors so even though I had to sand them down a lot, I left the color variation. Several coats of polyurethane later, we had a stable writing surface with a unique repurposed look. Would work great for any student desk or anywhere you need to place a laptop.
