



I found an old small dining table in East Asheville. I see many tables of this type – the wood is laminated alder, it's unstained, and it's usually made in China or Malaysia. It had the usual four corner legs and the top was really nicked up with water stains and paint. I completely sanded off the top and stained it a deep ebony. Then I built some custom trestle legs and painted them bright white. The contrast with the table top is great. When shined up with polyurethane, it's a completely different table from the one I found. The size is 4 feet by 3 feet, easily seats four and fits in those tight Asheville kitchens.
