



I found the frame of an old aquarium stand in Asheville. The metal was a bit rusted and chipped, so I sanded the rust off and spray painted it shiny black. One leg was slightly bent so I straightened that out. Then I added some red oak trimmed in white pine to both the top and bottom to make some useful shelves. With some sanding and polyurethane, the resulting piece is perfect as a side table or entry table with that wood-and-metal look. Solid and great looking.
