



We found an old, worn pine table in Asheville. The top was heavily stained and the boards had begun to separate. We took it apart, re-joined the edges to make the boards tight, completely sanded down the surface and restained it for a weathered pine look. Adding a black iron pedestal base makes it a great gathering table. Chairs can be crowded around all sides and corners. Also would make a great craft table.
