



A customer had a vacation lake house in Georgia with a limited size kitchen. She needed a kitchen island that would double as a kitchen table. That meant 36" high solid cutting surface with 24" benches for seating. The seats had to tuck all the way in so she could work standing at the counter. Unable to find this at the usual furniture stores, she turned to me. Her kitchen was mostly pine and other bright wood, so we use ordinary lumber plus some salvaged scraps, and used black pipe and black metal accents to set it off from the rest of her décor. I always love the natural wood with black details. Should look and work great in her kitchen.
