



We love the look of black metal with different kinds of natural wood. This table has chestnut on top and oak for the lower shelf. Both kinds of wood came from local barns in Hendersonville. The chestnut really shows its orange/auburn color when shined up with polyurethane. The black steel legs are construction lintels, which are used to span an opening and support the weight of brick or concrete above. But they also make great table legs. Makes a nice entry table or sofa table.
