



Black locust is a rare hardwood we find in North Carolina. Frequently the dark center of the tree is soft and mushy, it suffers from heart rot. However, I met a farmer in Hendersonville who found a perfectly clear black locust tree on his property. He sold me several live-edge slabs. They make GREAT unique looking tables. The black locust really shines when it is sanded and coated with polyurethane. Here we added a pair of student desk legs from the early 1900's and some funky metal brackets I found somewhere. Makes a one-of-a-kind entry, foyer, or sofa table.
