



Barn wood is all the rage, and while barn wood is easy to find, GOOD barn wood is scarce. Sometimes we find wood INSIDE an old barn rather than ON the barn. Here is some ambrosia maple we found in a retiring woodsmith's barn in Leicester. He had it sitting in a corner for over twenty years and forgot he had it. When he decided to sell it, we grabbed it. The wood was well-dried and very straight, the best kind for tables and bars. Here we joined two pieces from the same board, added a base made out of old pallet wood, and added some adjustable stools we found in Asheville and some metal casters. Result is a nice rolling bar with shelf storage that seats three.
