



I found a 100-year old oak table in Asheville – the owner had inherited it from his grandfather. One side was cracked beyond repair, so I cut it lengthwise and attached the good side on top; with some galvanized roofing scraps and some other salvaged wood, I made this serving bar. The foot rest is red oak off a barn in South Asheville. Has lower and upper shelf on the server side. Great item for the man-cave or covered porch.



70 inches long, 42 inches high, about 18 inches deep. Wood top is about 1-1/2 inches thick.
