Here I found a nice pair of them and made a small table out of some red oak I pulled off a barn in South Asheville. I stained the top a deep ebony color to even out characteristics of the repurposed wood. The top and the black cast iron legs is a nice contrast to the unstained red oak base. Makes for a small dining table for four. This is one stout little table.
