



OAK EPOXY TABLE

In Arden, I found the mother lode of pallets. Many were solid oak and a full 1 inch thick, most unusual for pallets. This wood had great character, color and saw marks. A customer wanted a large rustic oak table with those characteristics. I was able to piece together enough of the boards to create a table 86" by 46", with a beaded trim. The wood was a bit wavy and uneven, so I had to add an epoxy finish. The result really shows off the nature of the wood. Also found a thick pine beam to make the legs and added black metal pipe to hold it all together. Delivered the table to her cabin in Sapphire, NC. Now she has a one-of-a-kind conversation piece for her dinner guests.
