



This past summer I pulled some red oak off an old horse feeding shed in South Asheville. The wood was mostly straight and had that charcoal gray patina from years of sunlight – which made it great for repurposing. From some nicer boards I fashioned this dining room table, adding some turned legs of another salvaged table. The wood was various colors and had lots of veins and nail holes, so after cleaning that all up, I stained the entire surface in ebony to give it a more uniform look. Seats six.
