



We were looking through some wood at a lumberman's shop in Landrum and spotted two dark wood slabs that appeared to be black walnut. No, he said, that as tulip poplar – but unlike the usual canary yellow color of ordinary tulip poplar, it had taken on some dark mineral hues - was pulled from a swamp in South Carolina. We knew it would make a beautiful table.

Our customer had a specific size requirement to fit their long and narrow covered patio. They needed a table 32" wide (normal tables are 36") and 90" long (instead of the usual 72" or 84"). We made some custom legs similar to some he had seen in a magazine, painted them green to match his house.
