



I bought an older oak table from a gentleman in Asheville. He said he inherited it from his grandfather – the table was over 100 years old. The top showed its age – needed repair, sanding, and refinishing. I stained and finished it in a dark walnut stain. It looks great with the steel trapezoid legs and the pipe supports to keep it from wobbling. Despite its minimalist design, this table is solid.



72 inches long, 29 inches high, 36 inches wide. Top is about $\frac{3}{4}$ " thick.
