



I purchased an old coffee table from a rental unit company in West Asheville. It had a nice cherry wood pattern on top that was hidden under years of wear and tear. So I removed the low coffee table legs, completely sanded the top to expose a light cherry veneer, stained it gunstock brown, and added polyurethane for protection and shine. Then I made some more appropriate legs out of repurposed pallet wood and painted them black. Now it's a small dining or occasional table.
