



I found an old butcher block table made of maple in East Asheville. It had seen better days – top was nicked, had paint marks, and water stains. The legs were very plain and a bit rocky. So I refinished the top and stained it gunstock red. Then I made some more appropriate sturdy legs for it out of repurposed pallet wood and painted them flat black. Then for the final touch, I added a black metal rim around the top. The rim gives it that medieval look. The finished table is 48" wide and easily seats six.
