An ice cream shop wanted a vintage, repurposed look to their serving area. They needed a nice spot to dispense spoons, napkins, etc. They asked me to make a rustic serving table out of salvaged items. They wanted it a specific size to fit in their small serving and eating area. I used some ordinary pine and Douglas fir lumber salvaged from a home construction site for the top, and stained it dark walnut. The legs came off some construction pallets. After I distress-painted the legs, the finished table suggests chocolate ice cream- just what they wanted!
