



I acquired a small round table top in trade form some refinishing work. Like most older tables I find, the surface was fairly beat up with scratches and water marks. I brought it back to life with a lot of sanding and restained it in a dark ebony. Then I fashioned white pedestal legs out of some repurposed lumber. The result is a nice little dinette or side table. Great for those small Asheville kitchens.
