



If you've ever seen the underside of a bowling alley, iron support brackets are spaced along the lane very six feet or so. I salvaged some of these and used them to face the front of a console or TV table. Gives it that steampunk look. The top is reclaimed red oak from a barn in South Asheville. Since the oak had a nice rough gray patina, I left it unfinished and painted out the support wood in gray. Makes for a unique table.
